

RoHS III DECLARATION

Hazardous Substances Directive 2015/863 (EU) on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment

The Directive (EU) no. 2015/863, concerning the limits in the use of certain substances in electrical and electronic equipment, which was implemented as Directive 2011/65 / EU on 21/07/2011, establishes the limits of use in these products of the following substances:

- Lead
- Mercury
- Cadmium
- Hexavalent chromium (Chromium VI)
- Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB)
- Polybrominated diphenyl ether (PBDE)
- Bis (2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP)
- Benzibutyl phthalate (BBP)
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP)
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP)

Etelec Italia S.p.A. declares that none of its products affected by the legislation in question (including complex articles) contains any of the ten substances declared in the candidate list in EU Directive 2015/863 (RoHS 3) in a concentration higher than that established by the directive itself.
